

PRACTITIONER QUALIFICATIONS

All RAC practitioners have undergone a RAC course or its equivalent which includes classroom time, homework and many hours of case studies.

It is a mandatory requirement that all practicing members are enrolled in our Continuing Education Programme and, for this, they are designated RCRT (Registered Canadian Reflexology Therapist.) The enrolment covers a period of three years during which time the practitioner is required to earn a specific number of credits which are awarded for a wide range of activity including workshops, seminars, volunteer work and so on.
